KEY TRENDS

- + The **Pole-sitter** has won **only four of the last ten** races here.
- + ...but has set the fastest lap in **five of the last ten** races.
- + Despite the nature of the track, only **four of the last ten** races have seen a **Safety Car**.
- + **Every race so far this season** has seen a **first lap retiree**.
- + **50% of races** at Monaco have seen a first lap retiree.
- + However the **average lap of 1st retirement is relatively high**, thanks mainly to 2006.
- + Traditionally **approximately 60% of drivers are classified** in races here.
